The official start of spring is almost here, and with it comes a variety of landscaping projects. Whether you're adding trees and shrubs, installing a deck, or putting up a new fence, Wheat State Telephone reminds you to pick up your phone before you pick up your shovel.

Dialing before you dig isn't just a recommendation — it's the law. By digging without knowing where electrical, gas, cable TV and other service lines are, you could harm yourself or others, or interrupt services to your entire neighborhood. You may even incur fines and repair costs.

To make it easier, a national hotline now exists. Just dial 811, and representatives will route your request to local utility companies, who will have professionals mark



your lines. Call just a few days prior to doing any work, to allow time for them to mark your property. Then you can take on any project without compromising safety.

Kansas Lifeline ... You May Be Eligible!

If you are eligible, you can receive a discount on your monthly local telephone bill through the Kansas Lifeline program. If you don't currently have telephone service, you also may be eligible for a discount on your connection charge through Link Up America. You may qualify for Lifeline based on your annual income or if you receive assistance from any of the following programs:

- Food Stamps
- General Assistance
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)

- Temporary Assistance to Families
- Medicaid
- United Tribes Food Distribution program
- Head Start
- National School Lunch program

TAP Free Specialized Phones for Kansans

Individuals who have a hearing, vision, speech, cognitive or mobility disability/impairment can receive a free telephone if the following eligibility requirements are met:

- Have residency in the state of Kansas
- Have telephone service in the home/residence
- Have a disability or impairment in which a specialized telephone would be more helpful
- Have a household gross income of less than \$55,000 per year

Burglars Can Exploit Social Networking Sites

Users of social networking sites such as Facebook are giving away vital information that could potentially be used by professional burglars to establish a list of targets. This is according to research from UK insurer, Legal and General, which revealed that nearly 40 percent of Facebook users posted details of their vacation plans and by doing so, announced when their homes would be empty.

The research also found that users are putting their security at risk by being willing to be friends with people that they don't really know. Other trouble spots are the posting of home addresses and photos revealing a home's contents.

To reduce your odds of becoming a victim, experts suggest the following:

- Be particularly careful if you're a new user of Facebook and want to quickly build up your network. Don't let this goal get in the way of good judgment when it comes to friend requests.
- When you get a friend request, check to make sure the person is actually a friend of someone you know personally.
- Think twice about posting dates of your upcoming trips.
- Consider the contents of photos that you post. Do they show valuables in your home? Be sure to activate the site's privacy features.

You can request to start or stop receiving mail from individual companies within each category—or from an entire category at once.

OptOutPrescreen.com is a centralized service to accept and process requests from consumers to opt-out of these credit card offers. Once you provide your information, your name will be removed from inclusion on firm offer lists provided by all four companies.
